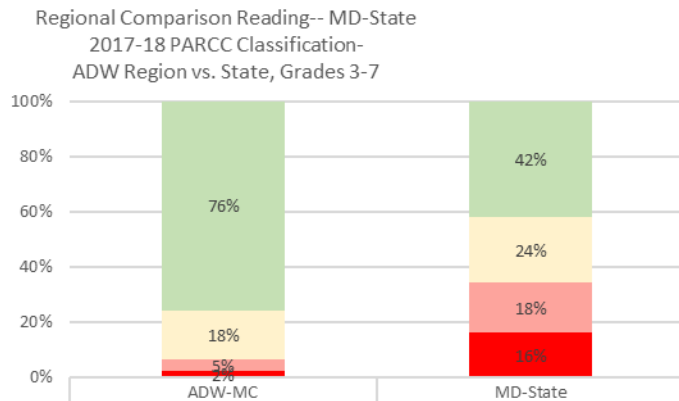
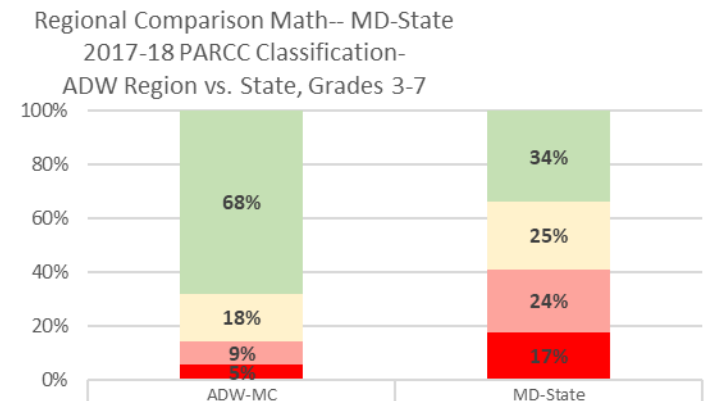


Regional Data Sample for the Scantron and Scantron PARCC comparisons

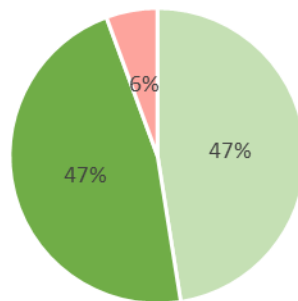

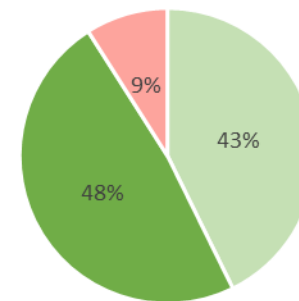
