OPERATIONS

Mary of Nazareth is following CDC guidelines in regards to class size, social distancing signage, and recommendations for use of materials.

Cleaning Protocols (Updated 9.9.2021)

- Teachers will be asked to open their windows throughout the day to help with ventilation. While we have our attic ERV systems running 24/7, taking this precaution may help reduce transmission rates.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The health and safety of our students and staff are our ultimate goal. Health and Safety policies and procedures will follow the CDC and ADW guidelines for returning to Mary of Nazareth School. Our full time school nurse, Erin Phillips, RN, will ensure adherence to our Health and Safety policies and procedures. Please note that Mary of Nazareth School will not require students or teachers to be COVID-19 tested before returning for the 2021-2022 school year.

Parent Support for Health and Safety

Health Screening and Questionnaire (Updated 9.15.2021)

- Parents who have consistently sent children to school without completing the daily health questionnaire will be called back to school by administration.

Quarantine Procedures & Protocol (Updated 10.25.2021)

- If a student is sick with a covid-like symptom, a sibling will have to stay home *only* if there has been a known exposure to the sick sibling. The sick student will follow covid protocols as far as testing and a doctor's visit. These protocols were laid out in the letter sent out on September 22, 2021.
- If a student has Covid symptoms, in order to return to school we will need proof of either a Negative PCR Covid Test or a health care provider documenting that symptoms are due to a specific alternate diagnosis. If there was a known exposure, the student may return when quarantine is completed according to Maryland Department of Health and local guidance.

- If a student is required by a physician to be Covid tested due to symptoms that can not be explained by any other illness or testing, that child's sibling will need to stay home until PCR test results come back negative.
